

TEMPLATE OF TWO-PAGE EXTENDED ABSTRACT FOR ASCHT2019

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Abstract

This is the layout specification and template definition for a **two-page** extended abstract to be submitted to ASCHT2019, which will be held in Tokyo, Japan, September 3-7, 2019. The extended abstract should include the results and figures and be written in A4, single space, Times New Roman letters of 10 font size. It should include the title of the paper, authors' names and affiliations, a concise statement of the problem, method of approach, results and discussion, and conclusions. Please identify the corresponding author. The submitted extended abstract shall undergo a reviewing process to be selected for the conference. If it is accepted after necessary revisions, the extended abstract will be processed as final manuscript. Electronic submissions are strongly encouraged. Please submit your abstract in a Word or PDF format to the ASCHT2019 Secretariat via ASCHT2019 website (<http://www.ascht2019.com/>). Note that the maximum number of pages is **two** including figures and references, and the file size is limited to 5MB.

Keywords : Large eddy simulation, reacting flows, multiscale modeling, heat transfer (4-6 key words)

1. Introduction

This template can be found on the ASCHT2019 website. Please use the template when preparing your extended abstract submission. It is the author's responsibility to submit a correct manuscript; any errors in spelling, grammar, or scientific content will be reproduced as typed by the author. Submitted extended abstract will be reviewed by the scientific committee.

2. Page layout and style

Authors should observe the following rules for page layout. A highly recommended way to meet these requirements is to use this template (MS-Word) and check details against the corresponding example file.

2.1 Basic layout features

- Margins should be at least 20 mm (left/right), 25mm (top/bottom, except headers/footers).
- Check indentations and spacings by comparing to this example file (in pdf).
- The abstract file should be converted into pdf format before it is uploaded on the submission form.
- Maximum file size is 5 MB.

2.2 Headings

Section headings are centered in boldface with the first word capitalized and the rest of the heading in lower case. Sub-headings appear like major headings, except they start at the left margin in the column. See the examples given in this file. No more than 2 levels of headings should be used.

2.3 Text font

Times New Roman font should be used for the main text. Recommended font size is 10 points which is also the minimum allowed size. Other font types may be used if needed for special purposes. It is very important that while making the final pdf file, you EMBED ALL USED FONTS!

2.4 Figures

All figures must be centered on the page. Figure captions should follow each figure and have the format given in Fig. 1.
